Main duties and responsibilities

- Working closely with the General Manager and TS Manager with regards to organization of site processes to maximise throughput and production in the most efficient and cost-effective manner possible.
- Liaising with specialist contractors (electricians, welders etc) to ensure any repairs/maintenance requiring external input are carried out promptly to ensure business continuity.
- Managing contractors onsite and ensuring they are inducted, RAMS completed and appropriate permits to work are issued
- To carry out other tasks that the Company may reasonably expect to be done and that are within the capabilities of the job holder whether this is on their usual site or another within reasonable travelling distance that belongs to or is managed by the Business or another GRG company.
